**A Guide to the Paperless Post Invite System**

As the Anyvite invite website that the MCG has been using for the last few years has now shut down we are now using the Paperless Post (PP) invite system. A few PP invites have been sent out in the last couple of months so we would like to go through the steps required to register with PP.

1. For each general member event organised by the Events Planning Team you will receive a personal invitation as per the one to the left from PP.
2. You can reply to the invitation directly from this page by either clicking the "will attend" or "will not attend" links, which I have circled, at the top of the page.
3. If you would like more details of the event please click on the "view the card" link at the bottom of the page, also circled. This page will have general details of the event plus a map. Scroll down the newly opened page to "Note", this is where you will find full details of the event, including special instructions, if necessary.
4. You may also rsvp from this page by clicking "Will Attend" or "Will not Attend" links under the title of the event.
5. It is important that you both open and rsvp to each of the PP invitations that you receive. PP is set up to send out reminders weekly to those that haven't opened or rsvped to a specific event. If you don't want to receive these constant reminders the best thing to do is just "open & rsvp" to the various PP invitations.
6. PP sends out individual personalised invites to all on the MCG address list so unfortunately you can no longer forward an invite link to friends to enable them to register on their own behalf. If you would like to bring a friend to one of our events please send us a message or comment in the comment section letting us know your guest's name/names via PP. If you have any queries about a specific event please also send us a message via PP.
7. Please ensure that you add paperlesspost@paperlesspost.com to your contact list to make sure you receive all MCG invitations.
